Debaty is a social platform for sharp but respectful debate. It is developed and managed by JGHP B.V., established in the Netherlands. Debaty is the trade name under which this happens; the company behind it is therefore the same party you address if something goes wrong.

Debaty is small. That is stated here because it matters: it determines how quickly you get an answer and how many people can look at a notice. What that means in practice is set out in the [moderation policy](#).
